

## Kitty Cat Planters Upcycle



### Supplies:

- Soda bottles
- Scissors and/or Xacto Knife
- Spray Paints
- Sharpie to draw the cat shapes for cutting them out.
- Paint Pens – black, pink, and white, if you paint one of your cats black.
- Gravel
- Potting soil
- Plants

### Instructions:

1. After peeling the labels off the bottles, draw your cat bodies on them. If you can't get all the glue off the bottles, put the glue spots in the back, where the tail will be. Put the little ears in front and the tail in the back. Make sure the front lines up with the little bumps on the bottom, which will be the cats' feet.
2. Use scissors or the Xacto knife to carefully cut out the cat shapes.
3. Use spray paint to paint your cats whatever colors you want. Start with the back sides, as you will need to roll the cats over to do the fronts. They may need two or three coats of paint.
4. Once they have dried, use your paint pens to paint the details on the cats, like little closed eyes and eyelashes, noses, lips, ear insides, and whiskers, as shown in the first image.
5. For drainage, put gravel in the bottom of the planters, then add potting soil and your choice of plants! Enjoy your adorable kitties!
