Jellyfish Paper Plate Project

Supplies needed:

paper plates tissue paper scissors glue hole punch yarn googly eyes black marker



- 1. Cut or tear the tissue paper into small squares.
- 2. Draw a wavy line in the middle of the paper plate. Cut along that line.
- 3. Glue the tissue paper to the paper plate halves, making jellyfish bodies.
- 4. Use a hole punch to make holes along the bottom edge of each jellyfish.
- 5. Punch a hole at the top of each paper plate half to hang the jellyfish.
- 6. Cut varying lengths of yarn for jellyfish tentacles, thred them through the holes at the bottom of each jellyfish body, then tie them securely
- 7. Add googly eyes so your jellyfish can se, or draw eyes for them.
- 8. Thread yarn through the top hole in each jellyfish to hang them up.
