

DIY GALAXY SLIME

Kids will love making their very own galactic slime mixing these different glittered slimes.

INGREDIENTS TO MAKE GALAXY SLIME:

Here are the ingredients you'll need to make one of the colors (if you plan to make all 4 colors you'll need to grab 4 of each of the ingredient amounts below).

- 1 Bottle of Elmer's Glitter Glue (6 oz). Suggested colors: black, blue, purple and pink
- 1 TBSP or more (up to 1 cup) water which will make your slime stretchier
- Silver glitter (*optional for more dimension in your galaxy*)
- ½ TBSP Baking Soda
- 1½ TBSP of Contact lens solution (*Note: contact lens solution must contain boric acid and sodium borate.*)

HOW TO MAKE GALAXY SLIME:

1. Combine all ingredients to make your first color of the galaxy slime.
2. Repeat until you've made all the colors you want to include in your galaxy.
3. When all of your colors are made, line them up in a row and twist to make your galaxy.



GALAXY SLIME SAFETY AND PRECAUTIONS:

Making slime is a science experiment and safety precautions should still be made when creating slime. Adults should handle any chemicals and products. Always read and follow the labels of products used. Slime should not be placed in the mouth. Always wash hands before and after playing with the slime. If you notice any skin irritation, discontinue use immediately.
