

Fairy Tale Story Stones

What are Story Stones:

Story stones are a prompts used to create stories. Each rock has a different picture prompt; characters, scenes, or object from a story. You can create sets of story stones to follow along with a book or story that kids are already familiar with.

How do you play with Story Stones:

Story stones can be used along with a story or picture book or they can be used for creative play and make up your own fairy tale! Playing with Story Stones allows the opportunity for imaginary play and language development. To create stories, lay your stones out (either facing up or facing down) and take turns to pick/flip a stone and create a sentence incorporating the picture prompt on the stone.



How to create Story Stones:

- Dragon

How to Make the Story Stones:

1. Gather the necessary supplies: stones, paper, scissors, colored pencils, mod podge, and paintbrushes.
2. Find flat stones either outdoors or you can purchase 2" painting rocks online
3. Print or draw your design/object/character etc for your story rocks and color them in with markers colored pencils.
4. Cut paper into small circles to fit stones, ensuring the paper is flat doesn't over hang the stone.
5. Paint the top of the stone with Mod Podge, then stick your image on before adding another layer over the top with Mod Podge to seal.
6. Allow the stones to dry and then get creative and start story telling!
