



Fairy Tale Treasure Baskets



Treasure baskets can be filled with everyday objects which then become a treasure trove to ignite and spark imaginations and learning. All you need to bring your stories to life is a basket and a few items and props you will need to recreate the story.

Three types of treasure baskets

General Treasure Basket

Including everyday items or items relating to a theme such as healthy eating, rainbows, loose parts, remote controls, musical items, natural items, explore colors, Numbers, letters of the alphabet.

Story Baskets

Bring stories to life with a basket for a class book. Include all the items and props you will need to recreate the story. Allow the children to investigate and find extra items to add. Children could then choose a different story and create their own basket for that story.

Sensory Baskets

Including sensory items such as texture, color, smell/ aroma, noisy/crinkly, bells, taste, light up, glow in the dark objects, metallic/shiny objects, natural items such as pine cones, leaves, conkers, flowers, stones, seeds – the possibilities are endless!
