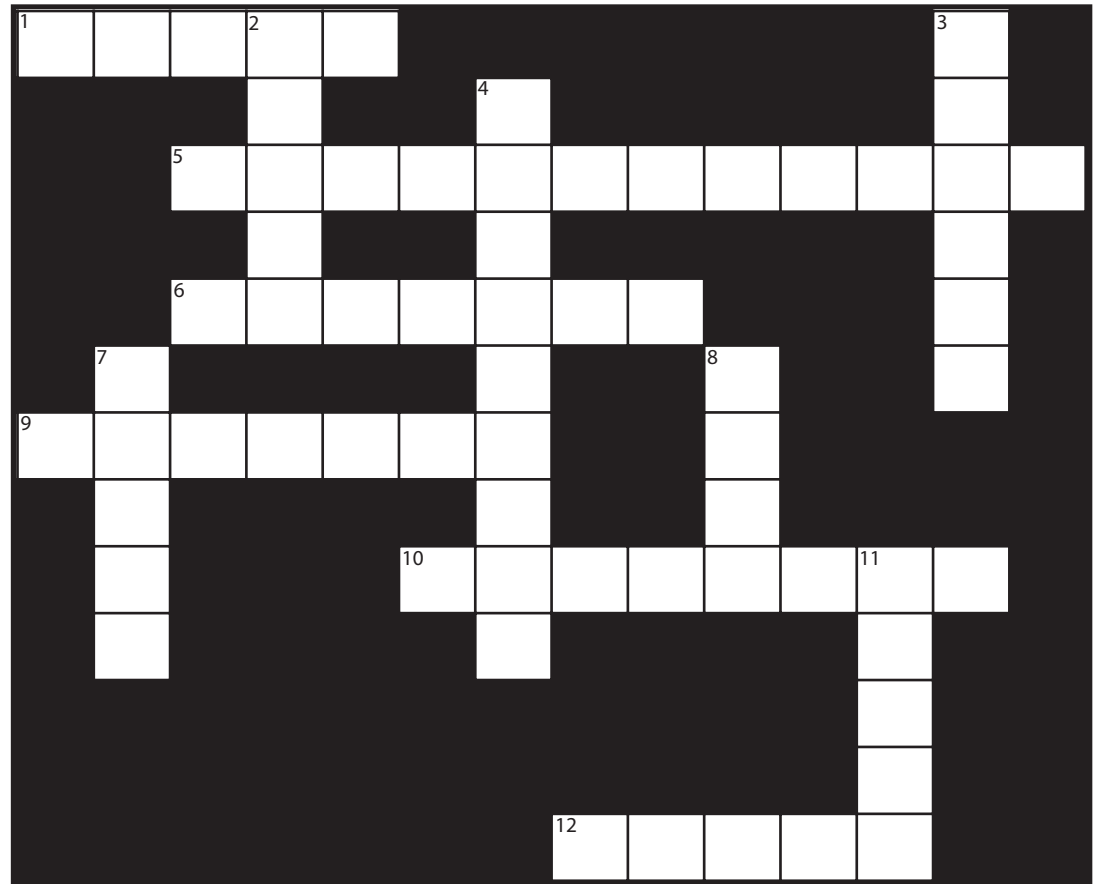


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Crossword Puzzle

- 12 - To figure out the answer to a mystery

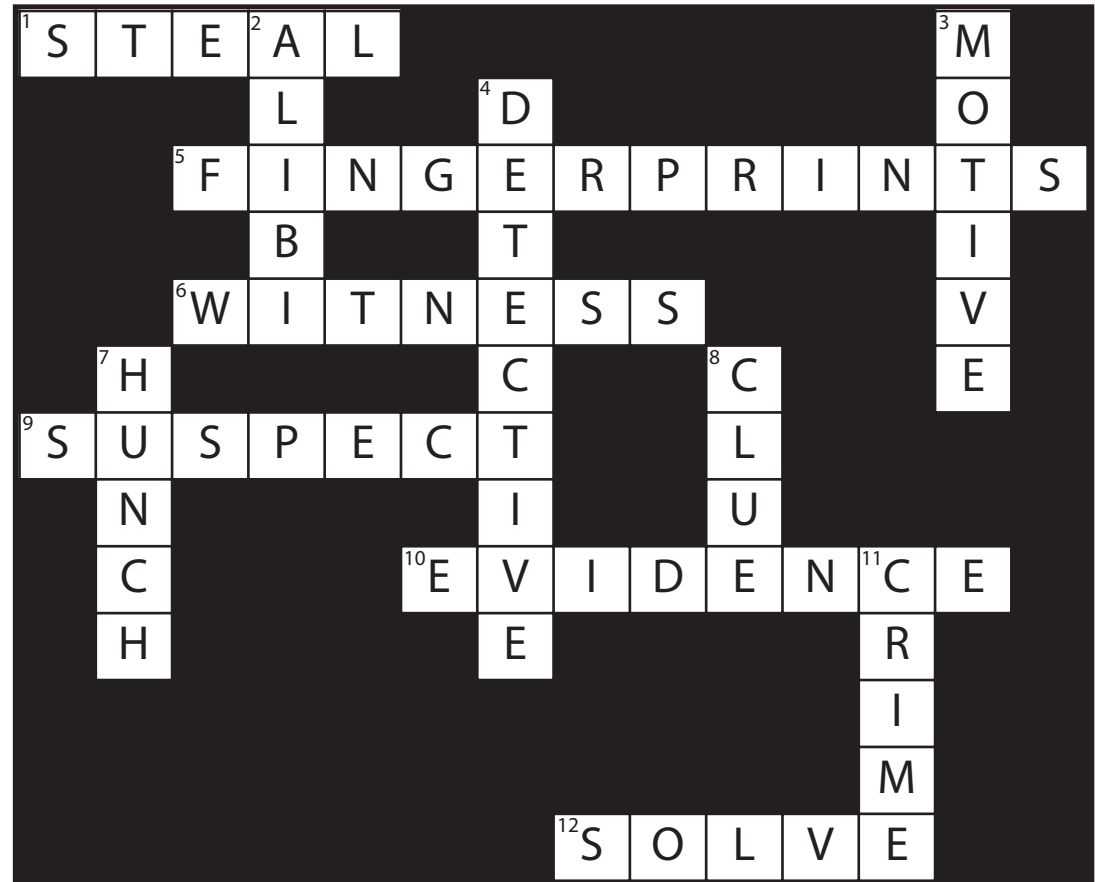
Down
